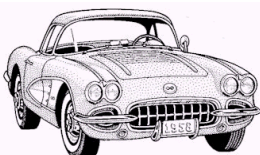

With that, I have babbled long enough; "On the road again, can't wait to get on the road again, travelin' to places the I've never been....."

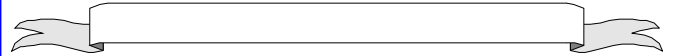

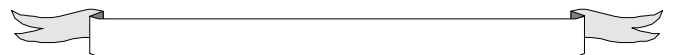

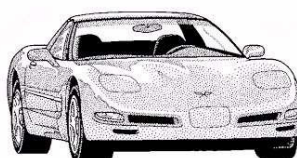
