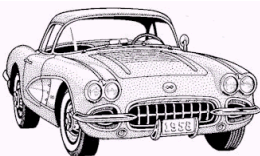

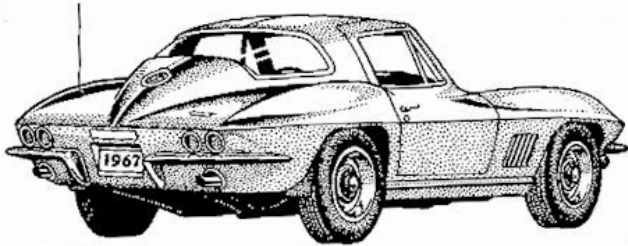

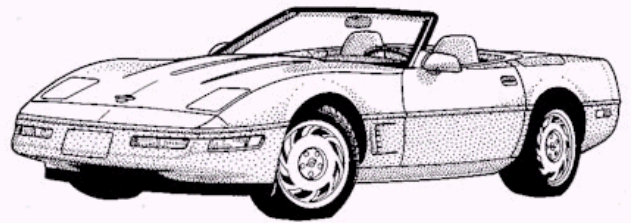
I'm looking forward to another fun year of Corvette activities with many good friends!
