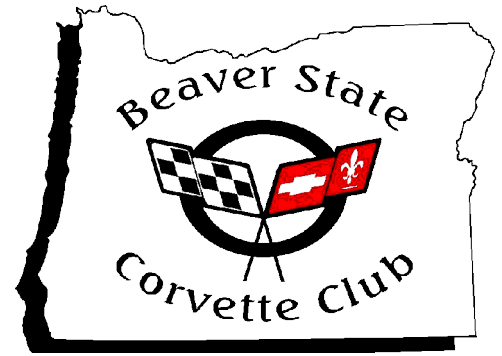

CALLING ALL CARS AND MEMBERS FOR THE HERITAGE MALL SHOW.

We are scheduled to have our cars at the Heritage Mall this Friday the 3rd thru Sunday the 5th and we are currently short on both the cars participating and the volunteers for the club table.

Everyone will meet at the Red Robin Restaurant across from the mall at around 7:30pm. Friday. We will enter the mall at 9:00pm.

Please note the following Heritage Mall Motorized Vehicle Guidelines for Exhibitors:

1. Motorized vehicles are not allowed into or out of the building until authorized by mall security or mall staff.
2. Reving up or leaving a motorized vehicle running while it is not moving is prohibited.
3. Drip pans for the engine and transmission must be placed under the all motorized vehicles.
4. No Armor-All or Tire Black is allowed in the mall or on vehicles.
5. Cardboard or carpet squares should be placed under the tires.
6. Gasoline tank shall be substantially empty and the gas cap must be locked, closed or taped in place.
7. Vehicles must be parked to maintain an aisle width capable of allowing customers to exit the mall in the event of an emergency.
8. Battery cables shall be left connected.
9. Vehicles should be as dry as possible before bringing them into the mall.
10. Tires should be as rock-free as possible and wiped dry before entering the mall.
